Background

The GPRRA represents the future of General Practice and is the peak, national representative organisation for GP registrars in the Australian GP Training Program environment. The Company is established with the object of recognising and supporting the needs of General Practice Registrars in Australia.

The GPRRA consists of an Advisory Council, comprising of all the Registrar Liaison Officers of each Regional Training Provider and other National Representatives. The Advisory Council establishes the broad policy in our representative role for Registrars and the Board is responsible for the running of the organization. The GPRRA Board consists of 8 Directors which are elected each year at the GPRRA AGM; the Chair and Vice Chair shall be elected from the 8 successful members. The term of appointment for all these positions is 2 years.

A GPRRA board director is bound to act in the best interests of the Company, in accordance with the Corporations Act 2001 and the GPRRA Constitution.
